The results of this research show that the value of honest character in traditional games and its impacts can be seen in the research results as follows: 1). Honest values in traditional games include: Obeying game rules, praying before playing, admitting mistakes in the game, reprimanding mistakes and apologizing to friends. The positive and negative impacts of the traditional Selodor game on the value of honest character include positive impacts, the costs required are low, develop children's gross motor skills, can develop social intelligence, they can use their free time by playing games which are very useful and the negative impact is that the Selodor game has risks. in the form of small fights, neglecting obligations when they are busy playing and feeling a little "reluctant", not being able to go back to studying when students feel tired, students choosing to sleep if it disturbs the learning process, children always drinking cold sweet and fizzy drinks after playing on selodor. , Requires a large area of land so you need to look for large and roomy land and requires more energy, so not everyone can play it.

INTRODUCTION

People have different characters, because they grow up in different environments. In this way, the environment plays a very large role in shaping a person's behavior.

Traditional games tend to contain social character values, while modern games tend to contain individual character values. Through play, children can express themselves, which will give birth to various creativity and skills that can later support success in life. Apart from that, introducing traditional games to children is the initial stage in cultivating a spirit in children to love and know the nation's culture.

RESEARCH RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

1. Selodor as Traditional Games Can Increase the Value of Honest Character Education.

This research, through observation, interviews and documentation, was successful and was able to find several facts that the formation of honest character in students can be done by habituating students, one of which is by applying it in games. The traditional game of selodor has a significant impact on children's character, especially honest character. This honest character will be

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formed if this game continues to be played at school and becomes a mandatory sport in elementary schools. Instilling the value of honesty in school and/or in games only serves to strengthen the value of honesty that has been instilled in children. If there is negligence in children who commit dishonest actions, it is the teacher's and even their friends' job to reprimand and direct them to the truth.

The ways to increase the value of honest character in the game of selodor are as follows: 1) Obey the game rules, 2) Pray before playing, 3) Admit mistakes in the game, 4) Reprimand those who make mistakes and 5) Apologize to friends.

2. The Positive and Negative Impact of the Traditional Selodor Game on Honest Character Values.

a. Positive Impact

- 1) The costs required are light because the equipment used is easily obtained.
- 2) Develops children's gross motor skills through many basic movements such as running and jumping.
- 3) Can develop social intelligence.
- 4) They spend their free time playing games which are very beneficial for their bodies instead of exercising, so that their bodies become fit.
- 5) Apart from that, the character values, which have rarely been exposed, appear when they play the selodor game.
- 6) They show annoyance when their playing friends cheat and decide to appoint a referee to determine whether the game is right or wrong. From this incident, it can be seen that the value of honesty can be instilled through traditional

games, especially selodor, which incidentally has relatively more players than other traditional games.

b. Negative Impact

- 1) Selodor games are not that significant because each game carries the risk of small fights, neglect of obligations if you are already having fun playing and a feeling of being a little "reluctant".
- 2) go back to studying when you feel tired after playing and choose to sleep if you sweat a lot.
- 3) The first habit of children who are thirsty after playing is to drink cold, sweet and fizzy drinks.
- 4) It requires a large area of land so you need to look for large and airy land
- 5) Requires more energy, so not everyone can play it.

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
