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# The Story of Yusuf in Genesis 39:11-23 and its Implications for the Attitude of Christian Youth in Facing Promiscuity

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#### Abstract

This article discusses the story of Yusuf in Genesis 39:11-23 and relates it to the implications for the attitudes of today's Christian youth in dealing with promiscuity. The aim of this research is. (1) what can be learned from Yusuf's steadfastness in facing the temptations of Potiphar's wife (2) why did Yusuf choose to respond to Potiphar's wife's offer by refusing, even though there were big risks he had to face. The true embodiment of promiscuity is the glamorous world (discothegues), which is often reported to contribute to drugs, free sex and other destructive behavior. These activities not only carry health risks such as HIV/AIDS transmission, but also have serious social consequences, including dysfunction in personal life and society. Apart from that, drunkenness, drug use and joining

gangster groups are clear examples of how promiscuity can damage the future of the vounger generation.

For new Christians, maintaining a holy life is an important principle taught in the Bible. This includes protecting thoughts, words, and actions from destructive things, such as sex outside of marriage and drug addiction. Christian youth are also expected to be role models for those around them, showing a different attitude towards life that shows integrity, honesty and love (Messakh & Messakh, 2023).

The Bible strongly warns that "bad company corrupts good habits" (1 Corinthians 15:33). Therefore, Young Christians are advised to choose a social environment that can foster the development of their faith, by avoiding bad influences that can destroy existing habits. Therefore, this research aims to analyze the lessons that can be taken from Yusuf's persisten ce in facing the temptations of Potiphar's wife, a s reported in the Book of Genesis. 39:11-

23. This research also aims to investigate the rea sons that caused Yusuf to reject Potiphar's wife's offer, even

though he had to face a great risk. Additionally, this research explains how the suffering Yusuf experienced after being slandered can be an important example for young Christians about the consequences of making good decisions. Lastly, this research examines how the young generation of Christians can remain firm in their faith, especially in the context of promiscuity, despite being ridiculed or negatively influenced by society.

#### **METHOD**

This research method uses a textual (biblica l exposition), moral theology, psychology and s ocial cultural approach to understand and apply the values contained in Genesis 39:1123, especi ally in the context of Christian free association ( Kasingku & Sanger, 2023)i. Today. young people the textual approach is carried out through studying the historical context, analyzing central themes such as moral integrity and self-control, as well as relevant explanations regarding Yusuf's character as an example of faith and perseverance. The moral theology approach explores the values of sincerity, honesty and obedience to God as practical learning for the younger generation of Christians facing the challenges of promiscuity. The psychological approach illustrates Yusuf's mental strength to resist pressure, as well as his strategy to avoid tempting situations, which can be an important lesson for the moral stability of Christian teenagers. Meanwhile, Menghu's social and cultural approach

connect the challenges faced Yusuf with pressure party couple Of modern society, empha sizes the importance of protecting the environm ent Which positive and respect values faith Implications of this research between other is strengt hen faith through prayer and living in a Christia n community, as well as the importance of main taining integrity and honor as a form of respect to God.

#### RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

#### 1. The Political Context at the Time of Yusuf

The period of Yusuf's leadership occurred under the rule of the Egyptian Pharaoh, with a complex and challenging political situation. Yusuf, who was appointed Pharaoh's deputy, played an important role in the government after his dramatic life journey, including betrayal by his brothers, imprisonment, and finally accession because of his ability to

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interpret Pharaoh's dreams. The dream revealed there would be seven years of abundance followed by seven years of famine. Yusuf used his influence to design strategic policies that were able to maintain Egypt's stability during times of crisis.

Yusuf in the fight against hunger Yusuf implemented a longterm strategy to overcome the famine, be ginning with accumulating food reserves during seven years of abundance. With the approval of Pharaoh Yusuf built storage facilities throughout Egypt to handle agricultural produce. shortages hit, these food reserves were distributed not only to the Egyptian people, but also to neighboring countries. Yusuf also sells food to his extended family. who came from Canaan. In addition, Yusuf established a policy of purchasing land from people who were unable to provide for themselves, so that the land became the property of Pharaoh. This action strengthened the government's power

b. center and maintaining Egypt's political stability.

The political impact of Yusuf's policies Y usuf's policies were able to save Egypt fr om famine and at the time strengthen the country's political position. Egypt beca me a supply center for its neighboring co untries, thus strengthening its reputation as the dominant power in the region. Yu suf also increased Pharaoh's wealth and authority through his land acquisition policies. This strategy does not only addres s economic challenges, but also ensures solid political stability, both at the nation al and regional levels.

c. Social Structure and Government
In Yusuf's time, Egypt had an organized social structure under the authority of the Pharaoh. Strict social hierarchies divided society into specific classes, from nobles to serfs. Yusuf, although originally a slave, managed to attain a high official position through his competence and integrity, reflecting opportunities for social mobility for talented individuals.

The centralized government structure made it easier for Yusuf to implement his policies, especially during the famine crisis, so that the country's stability was maintained.

## d. Religious Beliefs

Ancient Egypt was polytheistic, with belief in many gods and goddesses influence various aspects of community life. However, Yusuf, as a monotheist, remained faithful to his belief in the One God. Even though he did not directly change Egypt's polytheistic system, Yusuf's presence brought the influence of monotheistic values which showed courage in defending his beliefs in a society with a different belief system.

Egyptian economic culture during Yusuf's time was centered on the Yusuf agricultural system. used agricultural produce during the fertile period to be stored in the warehouses he established, ensuring food availability during times of hunger crisis. His policies in managing natural resources not only saved Egypt from economic collapse but also strengthened Egypt's position as an economic center in the region.

#### f. Language and Literature

The ancient Egyptian language, with its hieroglyphic writing, was widely used for a variety of purposes, including administrative and religious. The culture of writing developed rapidly during Yusuf's time, enabling more effective management of state administration. The role of language in government makes it easier for Yusuf to convey his policies systematically to the people and other officials.

### g. Family Values

Family values were held in high esteem in Yusuf's time. This can be seen from the attitude of Yusuf who forgave his brothers who had betrayed him and took his family to Egypt to live in the fertile land of Goshen. This action reflects the strong values of reconciliation and solidarity, which strengthened the

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relationship between the people of Israel and Egypt at that time.

### 2. Social Situation in the Time of Yusuf
